International Faculty



Dr. Neil Martin, Ph.D, BCBA-D

Dr. Martin is the Director of International development for the BACB (Behavior Analyst Certification Board, USA). He is an expert in the science of behavior analysis with three decades of experience in the field as a clinician, academic, supervisor and researcher. He has established BACB approved Behavior Analysis course in many countries. As subject matter expert he generated the Autism Task List and the BACB Professional and Ethical Compliance Code for Behavior Analysts.



Dr. Karola Dillenburger, Ph.D, BCBA-D

Dr. Dillenburger is Professor of Behaviour Analysis and Education and Director of the Centre for Behaviour Analysis at the School of Social Science, Education and Social Work at Queens University Belfast. She is the Course Director of the MSc in Autism Spectrum Disorders (MScASD), has led the development of the MSc Applied Behaviour Analysis (MScABA), and supervises Doctoral Research Students. Professor Dillenburger is a Board Certified Behaviour Analyst-Doctoral (BCBA-D) and clinical Psychologist (HCPC) and has worked extensively in child care, education, and therapeutic settings.



Dr. Manish Vaidya, Ph.D.

Dr. Vaidya is an Associate Professor and Chair of the Dept. of Behavior Analysis at Univ. of North Texas, USA. He received his Ph.D. and post-doc training at the Univ. of Florida and Univ. of Kansas. Having spent two decades studying basic processes in stimulus control and concept formation, he is currently involved in the application of behavioral science in health and medicine such as pediatric oncology and physical rehabilitation from surgery or injury. Dr. Vaidya believes that behavioral sciences can be a useful ally in managing health and healthy behavior.



Dr. Amiris DiPuglia, M.D., BCBA

Dr. DiPuglia obtained her degree as a medical doctor in 1991 from the Pontifical Catholic University and master's from the Dominican Republic. When her eldest son Alexander was diagnosed with autism, she abandoned her medical career and pursued her certification as a behavior analyst. In the last 12 years she has provided training and consultation to staff and family in educational programs as well as homebound service providers to facilitate collaboration. She is currently an educational consultant for PaTTAN, serving as a parent consultant.



Dr. Clodagh Murray, Ph.D. BCBA-D

Dr. Murray is Asst. Professor at Emirates College for Advanced Education, Abu Dhabi, UAE. She graduated with her Ph.D in ABA from Ireland Galway. Her research investigated behavioural variability in children and adolescents with ASD. Dr. Murray has worked in early intervention and used behavioural interventions on people with acquired brain injury. She started the first ABA programme in a mainstream school in Ireland and led a team of behaviour analysts on literacy and numeracy skills as well as at risk behavior in teenagers in mainstream school.



Dr. Lina Slim, Ph.D., BCBA-D, CCC-SLP

Dr. Slim is a Certified and Licensed Speech-Language Pathologist and Behavior Analyst with over 30 years-experience. She specializes in the diagnosis and management of children with Apraxia, neurodevelopmental and behavioral disorders and Autism, with a focus on Interprofessional Collaborative Practice and Education. She is the Founding Director of ASAP – A Step Ahead Program in USA. Dr. Slim received her PhD. in Leadership and Interprofessional Health Sciences Administration from Seton Hall University, and her Master's degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders from The University of Pittsburgh.



Dag Stromberg, BCBA

Mr. Dag is Speech and Language Pathologist and Behavior Analyst. He has extensive experience in running high quality programs for children with autism and learning disabilities, teaching and supervising at various centers in Sweden and France. He is the president of the Swedish Association for Behavior Analysis. Trains and supervise staff at a rehabilitation center for young children with autism. He develops and implements training programs, quality control and fidelity measures.

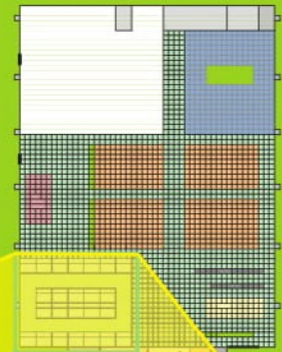
