1. Tenders in any other form except by e-tendering through e-procurement website will not be entertained.
2. Interested parties may submit their offer online by 11.08.2022 up to 3.00PM. The Director, NIEPID, Secunderabad reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without giving any reason thereof.
3. The tender is required to be submitted through e-procurement online under single bid system (Go to website [www.eprocure.gov.in/eprocure](http://www.eprocure.gov.in/eprocure), click on tenders by organization and select National Institute for the Mentally Handicapped).
4. Firm has to provide Subscriber Number allotted by the publisher. The books available in dual currencies should be billed in the currency by which the converted cost is the lowest in Indian rupees.
5. The successful firm will be required to deposit the security amount @ 3% of the total order value in the shape of Bank Guarantee till completion of supply of books. The amount of Bank Guarantee will be released only after completion of supply of issue(s) of BOOKS only. No interest will be paid by NIEPID on Security money.
6. The Firm/Agency has to specify clearly the Flat discount to be given for the supply of books keeping in view the total order value. Such discount will be subject to deduction from the bill amount itself.
7. Books issues so ordered ought to be delivered by hand/post/courier in the NIEPID Regional Centre Noida, C-44A, Sec-40, Gautam Budh Nagar, Noida-201301 (U.P.) Library in good condition.

10. Activation of online books has to be done by the firm without charging any additional charges or subscription.
