2. Interested parties may submit their offer online by 25.08.2021 up to 3.00PM. The Director, NIEPID, Secunderabad reserves the right to accept or reject any offer without giving any reason thereof.
3. Firm has to provide Subscriber Number allotted by the publisher against. The books available in dual currencies should be billed in the currency by which the converted cost is the lowest in Indian rupees.
4. The successful firm will be required to deposit the security amount at the @ 3% of the total order value in the shape of Bank Guarantee till completion of supply of books. The amount of Bank Guarantee will be released only after completion of supply of issue(s) of BOOKS only. No interest will be paid by NIEPID on Security money.
5. The Firm/Agency has to specify clearly the Flat discount to be given for the supply of books keeping in view the total order value. Such discount will be subject to deduction from the bill amount itself.
6. Books issues so ordered ought to be delivered by hand/post/courier in the NIEPID RC Navi Mumbai B-102,Vasundhara CHS, Plot No.13-14,Sector-8, Kharghar, Navi Mumbai, Maharashtra- 410 210 Library in good condition or in any other location in Navi Mumbai which will be indicated in Purchase Order.
7. The firm/Vendor has to inform the NIEPID RC Navi Mumbai Library about the availability of free online access to order books.
8. Free online facility of books where ever it is applicable with the print order has to be IP authenticated on the Institute IP Numbers. In case if the firm or agency fails to provide the online accessibility within 45 days from the date of billing, the firm/agency will be imposed a penalty of 2% of the cost of the subscription of that journal per week.
9. Activation of online books has to be done by the firm without charging any additional charges or subscription.
